



Curriculum Information - Year 5

Autumn Term 1 – 2nd September – 25th October

English	<p>This half term in English the children will be studying:</p> <p>The World of the Unknown: Monsters by Carey Miller By the end of this unit children will write a non-chronological report about monsters. The second text we will study is Cloud Tea Monkeys by Mal Peet and Elspeth Graham Children will write a descriptive passage to describe settings, character and atmosphere. Our class text will be Krindlekrax by Philip Riddley. Children will develop their fluency and comprehension during regular guided reading sessions.</p>
Maths	<p>Our maths learning this half term will focus on: Place Value and Rounding of Large Numbers Interpret Negative Numbers, Place Value of Numbers with up to Three Decimal Places, Multiply and Divide by 10, 100 and 1,000, Properties of Number – Multiples, Factors and Common Factors, Prime and Composite Numbers, Multiply and Divide Mentally Solve Problems Involving Knowledge of Key Facts.</p>
Science	<p>Materials, Mixtures and separation.</p> <p>Pupils explore different types of mixtures and the different methods that can be used to separate them. They dissolve a range of substances, identify different solutions and investigate how temperature affects the time taken to dissolve. They design and create a water filter, sieve soil and evaporate solutions</p>
PE	<p>This term our P.E will be Fitness (Weds) and Swimming (Thurs)</p> <p>Children will attend swimming sessions at Hartham Pool every Thursday afternoon in the Autumn term. (beginning Thursday 19th September)</p>
