

## **Curriculum Information - Year 2**

## <u>Autumn Term 1 – Tuesday 3<sup>rd</sup> September 2024 – 28th October 2024</u>

Dear Parents/Carers,

It has been wonderful to see the children all back at school again this term and settling into Year 2! We will be covering a range of subject areas this half term as outlined below and our topic is Would you prefer to live in hot or cold place. Maths and RE will continue to be taught discretely.

English Maths	For the first week of this half term we will using the book Hermelin by Mini Grey to support us in our English lessons. The next texts that Year 2 will be studying are Frog and the stranger and How to make friend with a ghost by Rebecca Green. Children will be developing their knowledge of clauses and sentences. They will learn to retell familiar stories and to write a set of instructions. Our final unit of work is a poetry unit using the book The Fantastic Book of First poems by June Crebbin. During our spelling sessions children will revise the phase 5 phonemes and apply them to their reading and writing and begin to move onto phase 6 using the Little Wandle Scheme of work. Children will develop their understanding place value. They will be reading and writing numbers to 100. Recognise the place value of each digit in a two digit number (tens, ones) Identify, represent and estimate numbers using different representations
	including the number line. Compare and order numbers from zero up to 100; use <, > and = signs. They will be adding and subtracting within 20 and reinforcing their knowledge of number bonds to 10 and 100.
Science	Our Science topic this half term is Living things and their Habitats, Children will explore and compare the differences between things that are living, dead, and things that have never been alive. We will describe how different habitats provide for the basic needs of different kinds of animals and plants, and how they depend on each other.
PE	In this unit pupils develop their sending and receiving skills including throwing and catching, rolling, kicking, tracking and stopping a ball. They will also use equipment to send and receive a ball.
RE	Our first R.E. topic is about new beginnings. Children will learn about the creation story and that God is present in every beginning. Children will respond creatively to Psalms through art and dance. We will also begin our topic on signs and symbols in Baptism.
Humanities Arts Computing	Geography- Would you prefer to live in a hot or cold place. Art – Sculpting - Making Clay houses Computing – Coding. Music – Mrs Clifford will teach Music on alternate Mondays along side Miss Parmley. The topic this half term will be West African call and response. PSHE – children will cover a range of topics linked to returning to school. Topics include: belonging and feeling safe at school, reconnecting with friends, being positive towards learning and managing worries and fears.
Home Learning	Children will be expected to complete the following

<ul> <li>Daily reading – 10-15 minutes (please log this on go read)</li> <li>Weekly spelling activity to be set on google classroom each Friday.</li> </ul>
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<ul> <li>Times tables Rockstars – 10-15 minutes per week</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>Share the Wednesday Word Gospel reading with your child.</li> </ul>

Please make sure that your child has a water bottle each day clearly labelled with their name. P.E. and Learning outside the classroom will happen on a Friday. Please can children come dressed in their P.E. kit on a Friday for P.E. and outdoor learning. P.E. kits should not be kept at school.

## Cold Weather

As the weather begins to get colder, please ensure your child brings to school a jumper or cardigan and that they have a suitable coat and shoes to wear to enable them to take part in outdoor learning. Please also ensure your child brings to school a named water bottle each day.
