

## **Curriculum Information - Year 1**

## <u>Autumn 1- 3rd September – 25th October 2024</u>

Dear Parents/Carers,

Welcome to Year 1! I am very happy to be working with you and your children this year. I will be at the door every morning if you have any questions for me. P.E. and outdoor learning will be on Mondays. Homework is provided every Friday, on google classroom (or this can be printed off for you).

Autumn 1	
English	This half term we will focus on the texts Hermelin where we will write a thank you letter
	from one of the characters, Jasper's beanstalk where we write a set of instructions to
	help family learn how to plant and seed and to look after the plant, Puffin Peter where
	we will retell the story and make a new ending and Purple iswhere we create a list
	poem using adjectives.
Maths	This half term in maths children will firstly focus on positional language. We will use
	ordinal numbers to describe position (first, second). We will look at words to describe
	turn (quarter turn). We will then move onto finding patterns in numbers by using 10s
	frames and positioning numbers of counters in different ways to show less than, more
	than and equal to. Following this we will look at the positioning of numbers on a number
	line and will consider how we know where each number belongs. We will complete the
	half term looking at addition and subtraction using part whole models.
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Science	Our science topic is seasonal change. We will make mobiles which show the seasons, the
	months and the typical weather for each season. We will look at changes through the
	year in terms of clothing, trees and daylight hours. We will use thermometers to
	measure temperature and we will finish the half term by making our own weather
	reports!
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PE	We will have a PE session every Monday and children should come to school dressed in
	their PE kit every Monday. This half term we will focus on ball skills and developing skills
	to dribble a ball with hands and feet. We will practise working with a partner.
RE	In R.E. we will learn about families and consider who are my family and how families
	show love and care. We will then find out about Baptism and consider belonging and how we are invited to belong to God's family.
Humanities	Geography - Our geography topic is what is it like here? We will start by looking at aerial
Arts	photos of the school before making our own plans of the classroom and school grounds.
Computing	Children will talk about what they like and dislike about our playground before visiting a
. 0	local playground and then bringing their ideas back to decide how they could improve
	what we already have in our playground or add to it.
	Art - Our art topic is making our mark. Our inspiration will be the work of Bridget Riley.
	We will make lines with sting and chalk before exploring the lines of Zaria Forman in
	seascapes. We will then draw shapes before drawing from observation.

	Computing - We will start by teaching the children to log on, how to access purple mash and to use it and to be aware of how to stay safe when using the computer.
Home	Homework will be set every Friday on Google Classroom or will be printed off for you:
Learning	Reading ( 1 library book and 1 reading book per week)
	Phonics activity. Maths activity. Maths numbot practice.
