

Curriculum Information - Nursery

Spring 1-6th January - 14th February 2024

Dear Parents/Carers,

We hope you have all had a lovely Christmas and New Year making happy memories with family and friends. This half term our topic will be Fairy Tales and our focus texts will be The Gingerbread Man, The Three Little Pigs and Goldilocks and the Three Bears. We will also spend time learning about Epiphany, Chinese New Year and the change in season to winter.

Communication and Language	The children will start to listen to longer stories and join in with repeating parts using familiar fairy tales. They will answer a range of questions, starting to understand 'why?' in terms of investigations and problem solving. They will continue to learn how to respond appropriately to a range of questions and know the importance of listening carefully when someone else is speaking. We will be recalling our Christmas news and taking turns to share our news with the class.				
Physical Development	The children will continue to develop their independence in going to the toilet, washing hands, putting shoes and coats on and preparing and having their snack. In PE the children will be doing dance, learning different ways to move to music and we will also be starting Write Dance which will give the children a				
Personal, Social and Emotional Development	We will be having regular circle times to help us identify our different feelings and how we can be kind to our friends. We will link this with the feeling and attributes of characters in our core texts this half term. We will also continue to practise sharing, turn taking and calm and positive conflict resolution strategies when disagreements arise.				
Literacy	Our focus this half term is Fairy Tales where we will be reading The Gingerbread Man, The Three Little Pigs and Goldilocks and the Three Bears with lots of activities linked to these stories. They will make puppets, story maps and masks to help them retell the stories.				

Mathematics	This half term we will have a focus on 2d and 3d shapes including going on a shape hunt, sorting and painting them. We will also continue to practise our counting, subitizing and comparison. Then use manipulatives to show numbers to 5 in different ways.					
Understanding of the world	In Forest School we will be going on winter walk and identifying different signs of Winter. We will be learning to take care of our environment as we start to see shoots and buds emerging. We will be making gingerbread and porridge and walking to the shops to buy the ingredients we need. Our science focus is on materials.					
Expressive Arts and Design	We will be using instruments to help us tell stories, singing a variety of new songs and nursery rhymes and creating characters and settings from our focus stories with collage.					
RE	Our focus in RE is Galilee to Jerusalem and that Jesus was born for everyone. We will be reading and role playing stories from the Bible such as Jesus welcomes the little children and Jesus blesses the children.					

Key information:

Please ensure children arrive promptly at 8.40. Morning only children will be dismissed at the playground gate at 12pm and children staying all day will be dismissed at 3.15 at the rainbow gate. Parents must wait on the left hand side of the gate. Please notify the office before the end of the school day if somebody different will be picking your child up.

P.E. and outdoor learning will be on **Wednesdays** so please ensure they come to school wearing their PE kits. In this cold weather you may want to send in warm socks for Forest School as feet can get cold quickly in wellies.

Our library visit will be on a **Thursday** where the children can change their library books if they have returned their previous book.

Please ensure your child brings a jumper or cardigan and that they have a suitable coat as well as hat, scarf and gloves as the weather is now much colder. They must also have a **named** change of clothes to keep on their peg.
