ESSENTIAL VOCABULARY	
Word	Definition
Eucharist	The bread and wine are consecrated to become Christ's body and blood.
Mass	A ceremonial thanksgiving to God. It involves Gospel readings, hymn singing and the Holy Communion.
Liturgy of the Word	The part of the Mass where we hear the Word of the God proclaimed.
Liturgy of the Eucharist	A time to remember what Jesus did on the night before he died; he took bread and wine, gave them to his disciples and said. "This is my body; this is my blood".
Ambo	An oblong pulpit with steps at each end.
Gloria	A prayer of praise.
Holy Communion	An important religious service, where bread and wine is shared as a symbol of the Last Supper and the death of Christ.
