ESSENTIAL VOCABULARY	
Courage	Strength in the face of pain or grief.
Holy Week	The week before Easter starting on Palm Sunday.
Fasting	Means to go without food or drink.
Almsgiving	The practice of giving money or food to people in need.
Resurrection	The rising of Christ from the dead.
Sorrowful Mysteries	Traditionally prayer as part of the Rosary, providing an opportunity to meditate on events leading up to Christ's death. They cover the events of Holy Thursday, through to the crucifixion of Christ on Good Friday. They remind us how much Jesus loves us and how He suffered and died for us.
Gethsemane	Garden in Jerusalem where according to the New Testament, Jesus was arrested before his death.
Beatitudes	They are teachings from Jesus about how to be connected to God or 'have God live with you'.
Stations of the cross	A 14-step devotion that commemorates Jesus's last day on Earth.

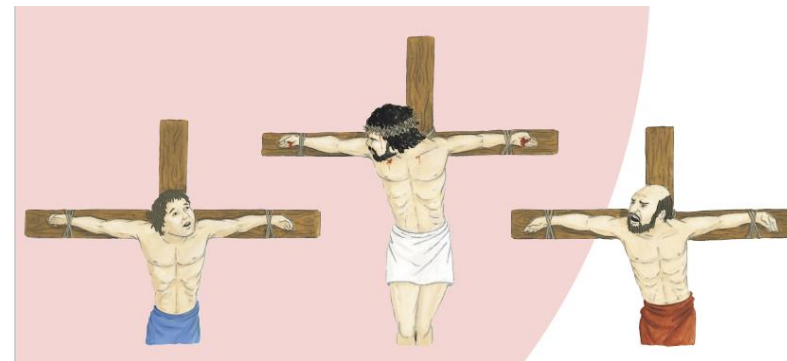
