
Prayers for Pope Francis



Nursery

In Forest School this week we found some little characters and decided we should make them houses. We worked in groups to use the natural materials around Forest School to make them homes. The children used great problem solving skills as it kept falling down to start with, so they had to think of ways to change it to make it stand up. The children then got very creative and added lots of decorations, a carpet, chairs etc. They worked well as teams listening and helping each other.









Reception

We had a busy start of the term in Reception. We shared our holiday news and recorded them in our writing books. We revised counting

strategies and in our art lesson, we made paper snakes. We also reminded ourselves of Pope Francis and his message for the world. Following his passing, we pray for Pope Francis every day.



Year 1

This half term we are going to be designing, making and tasting our own smoothies in D.T. So far, we have looked at how we know when a food is a fruit. The children are very excited that they will get to taste their smoothies in a few weeks! In science we are looking at plants and we have started this work by looking at what makes a plant. The children went on a plant hunt around the school and needed to find plants that matched certain criteria such as it smells, has a trunk or is taller than me!







Year 2

In our math's lessons we have been learning about repeated addition. We were introduced to the term multiple which means 'groups of'. We used bead strings to count in multiples of 2, 5 and 10 and worked together to write the matching repeated addition.
