

### <u>Curriculum Information - Year 3</u>

## Autumn Term 2 – 3<sup>rd</sup> November 2025 – 19<sup>th</sup> December 2025

Dear Parents/Carers,

We will be covering a range of exciting and engaging subject areas this half term as outlined below.

English	We begin the term by learning all about 'Fables. We will start with reading our key text 'The Lion Inside' by Rachel Bright and Jim Field. We will also read other texts in this series such as 'The squirrels who squabbled' and 'The Koala who Could'. The children will end the unit by writing their own fables.
	We will then move on to our second text, 'Incredible jobs you've probably never heard of' by Natalie Labarre. The outcome of the unit will be to write their own non-chronological report as well as studying the structure of a non-fiction text and how they are designed and created.  Our whole class guided reading text this term is 'Escape from Pompeii' by Christina Balit. We will also read 'The Abominables' by Eva Ibbotson as our class text.
Maths	Our maths learning this half term will focus on: written addition and subtraction and word problems. We will then move on to data and understanding bar charts. We will then look at shape, focusing on angles, lines and 2D shapes before finishing the term with perimeter and word problems.
Science	Our topic this half term is Forces and magnets.  Through various investigations and questioning, the children will:  Investigate the movement of vehicles on different surfaces, children learn about the impact of friction and compare uses and drawbacks.  Broaden their experience in writing scientific methods and recording data as they investigate contact and non-contact forces.
