



## Curriculum Information - Year 2

Spring Term 1 2025 – 5<sup>th</sup> January 2026-13<sup>th</sup> February 2026

Dear Parents/Carers,

Happy new year to you all and welcome back to the spring term. Our topic for this half term is “How did we learn to fly” Where possible lessons in all curriculum areas will link with this topic but English , maths and RE will be taught discretely.

<b>English</b>	This term the children will continue to develop their reading skills through spelling lessons and guided reading. We will also have regular handwriting practice. In our English lessons we will begin by focusing on the fairy tale of Rapunzel by Beth Woolvin. The children will be describing the characters and retelling the story. We will then move onto using the book Big Blue Whale by Nicola Davies and Nick Land to support us in our English lessons.
<b>Maths</b>	This half term Year 2 will continue to practice core number skills during regular maths fluency sessions. This half term our maths will focus on addition and subtracting. Children will be learning to add and subtract 2 digit numbers using manipulative resources and then written methods. We will also be using our knowledge of addition and subtraction to solve word problems and to find double or half or a 2 digit number.
<b>Science</b>	Our Science topic this half term is Materials. We will focus on recognising the suitability of materials for specific purposes, exploring how actions like stretching and bending affect solid objects, compare material suitability through tests and record data.
<b>PE/LOTC</b>	PE and Learning outside the classroom lessons will continue to happen on a Monday. In our PE lessons the children will be learning all about the different skills needed to play Invasion games.
<b>RE</b>	In RE our topic will focus on Branch 3 Galilee to Jerusalem. We will focus on the story of John The Baptist and the Baptism of Jesus. We will also begin to look at the importance of parables and how they teach people about God. We will take a closer look at different representations of Jesus Baptism, God the Father and the Holy Sprit and look at how they are connected. We will also look at making simple links with Isaiah and John the Baptist as prophets, and their openness to the Holy Spirit. Ending the topic with reflecting on what it feels like to say sorry and to be forgiven and then talk about ways that they and others show they are sorry.
<b>Humanities Arts Computing</b>	History – Our topic is “ How did we learn to fly’. During this unit of work the children will be developing their knowledge of events beyond living memory and reinforcing their chronological understanding by looking at significant events in the history of flight on a timeline. Learning about the individuals who contributed to the history of flight.  DT- The theme is Structures – Baby Bear’s chair. The children will explore stability and methods to strengthen structures, to understand Baby Bear’s chair weaknesses and develop an improved solution for him to use.  Computing – This will be taught by Mrs Digiullio on a Tuesday afternoon. The unit of work the children will be learning how to create pictures using Purple Mash.
<b>Home Learning</b>	Homework will be set every Friday on Google Classroom: Reading ( 1 library books and 1 reading book per week)

	Spelling activity each week and a weekly activity linked to maths or topic work. Times Tables Rock Stars
