<u>Believe</u>
<p>By the end of this unit of study, pupils will know that the Church teaches:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • John the Baptist is a prophet who calls people back to God. • Baptism is a sign of forgiveness. • That when people make bad choices (sin), they turn away from God. Jesus teaches that God loves and forgives and that being sorry helps us to change and become better people. • Jesus' miracles are signs that show he is the promised one (Messiah). • Jesus' parables are simple comparisons that invite people to know more about God. • Jesus brings healing in different ways
