



Curriculum Information - Year 3

Summer 2 Term – 1st June 2026 – 17th July 2026

Dear Parents/Carers,

We will be covering a range of exciting and engaging subject areas this half term as outlined below.

English	We begin the term by writing a non-chronological report. We will be look at the text 'A year full of celebrations and festivals'. It will be a great chance for children to explore festivals and celebrations from across the globe and eventually finish by writing their own non-fiction based report on a festival of their choice. After this, we will be looking at the text, 'The Iron Man' by Ted Hughes. The children will write their own sci-fi based narrative at the end of this unit. Finally, we will complete our year with a poetry unit which will be a fantastic opportunity for performance too.
Maths	Our maths learning this half term will focus on: time (analogue and digital), revisiting place value and revising concepts such as estimating and rounding. We fill finish the year by looking at 3D shapes and measure.
Science	Our topic this half term will be <u>Making connections.</u> Through various investigations and questioning the children will: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Plan their own enquiry• Design and record in results tables.• Complete, read and interpret data in a bar chart.• Identify and suggest changes to an enquiry.• Use results to draw conclusions.
PE	In PE this half term the children will be learning how to play Rounders in PE lessons with Miss Pickering PE will take place on a Wednesday afternoon.
RE	Our topic this half term is Dialogue and Encounter.
