



| Key Vocabulary | |
|------------------|--|
| Word | Definition |
| Primary colour | The primary colours are red, yellow and blue and from them all other colours can be made |
| Secondary colour | The secondary colours are orange, green and violet. We get these by mixing 2 colours together. |
| Warm colour | Reds, oranges, yellow and browns which can make you feel such things as anger or warmth |
| Cool colour | Cool colours such as green or blue can be thought of as calming. |
