<b>Myth</b>	A traditional story, especially one concerning the early history of a people or explaining a natural or social phenomenon, and typically involving <u>supernatural beings</u> or events.
<b>Ancient</b>	Old
<b>Mortal</b>	Like a human being (has a lifecycle)
<b>God/Goddess</b>	An immortal being
<b>Underworld</b>	the <u>mythical abode</u> of the dead, <u>imagined</u> as being under the earth.
<b>Moral</b>	a lesson that can be derived from a story or experience.

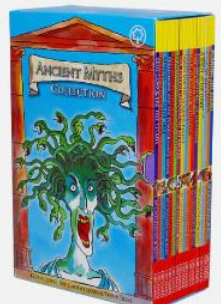
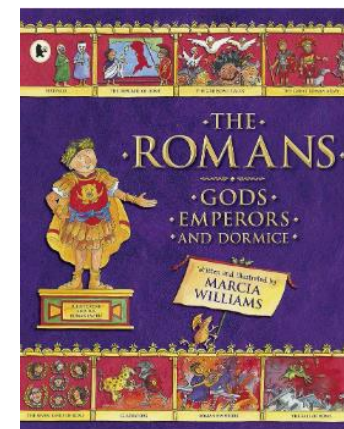
Simile/metaphors

### Inverted Commas

**Beginning and End**  
Keep your inverted commas at the beginning and the end of the words being spoken.  
"Stop!" I said.

**New Speaker, New Line**  
Start a new line whenever someone new speaks.  
"How are you doing today?" asked Henry.  
"I'm great!" said Ashton.

**Capital Letter**  
Begin what is spoken with a capital letter!  
"What an amazing day!" he announced.

**Commas**  
Remember to add commas.  
Ashton whispered, "Be quiet!"  
"Goodbye," said Jules.

**Punctuation**  
Make sure your speech is correctly punctuated!  
"There are times, I feel, that you are a little cold," I said.
